## **The ANZAC Day March, 25 April 2018**

Our Treasurer and Membership Officer, Comm. Gerard VANDER attended a pre-ANZAC Day March meeting at ANZAC House and noted the following: “Despite the fact that all Army formations are reversed, that is to say current conflicts, Vietnam, Korea, WW2 and then WW1, we (The Corps) are not affected.

Therefore we shall move off from our usual position in Swanston Street near Flinders Street Station at 0900 (usual place, usual time).

The Corps still retains the traditional privileged position at the very early part of The March, and it is always an honour for me to lead you to The Shrine of Remembrance.”

Just a note on medals and dress codes please:

Each year there are issues with medals and uniforms and civilian dress. Please be aware that service medals for Corps members are worn on the LEFT, and medals issued by The Corps and service medals for your relatives, which you wear on their behalf, are worn on the RIGHT. Please ensure that if you are wearing any type of medals, that they are properly mounted and put on straight.

Corps uniforms (with white caps) and civilian dress consisting of jacket, shirt and tie are the acceptable standard. Shorts, tee shirts, runners, etc. are not acceptable and those wearing same will not be able to march with The Corps.

Even though our numbers may be down, we will maintain our high standards of the past.

I encourage as many of you as possible to march this year, as 2018 will commemorate the end of WW1 which saw Australia, for the first time, fight as a Nation on that first ANZAC Day at Gallipoli.

If any of our members require transport by the generous RACV volunteer drivers, you MUST let Corps Secretary, John McIVER know as soon as possible so that it can be arranged.
